1.02 Announcements & Additions to the Agenda – Baseball & Softball by-law change to increase All FVL patches by 2 each.

2.0 CONSENT CALENDAR – Agenda – Placer moved to accept the agenda, Twelve Bridges 2nd, Unanimous Approval (UA).

2.01 FVL Expenses 2024-2025 – YC Moved to approve the expenses, Roseville 2nd, UA.

2.02 FVL Budget 2025-2026: 1st reading. A tentative budget was introduced with a \$50 reduction in dues. The AD's agreed to each receive 150 Scholar Athlete patches. The AD's requested that the FVL switch to vinyl pennants as they felt that the felt fabric pennants did not hold up as well.

3.07 Winter 2025-2026 Schedules 2nd reading: Boys Basketball (the schedule was changed so as to only have one week of 3 games in the week; Roseville and Twelve Bridges were concerned that they lost their Friday night games; after much discussion, River Valley moved to approve the schedule as is, Nevada Union 2nd, the vote was 5-2 in favor of approving the schedule. , Boys & Girls Soccer
