1.02 Review FVL BOM School Directory – Several Updates were made. Nevada Union Principal Kelly Rhoden will be the new FVL President replacing Greg Snyder, who left the FVL for a job in the Rocklin School District,

Another possible solution that was discussed by the flag football coaches was to keep the 6pm start but to start the varsity 15 minutes after the JV game ended, thus always allowing warm up time for the varsity, Frosh Football (Should a frosh football game and a Flag Football game be at the same location, ADs are to contact the opposing school to set start times for each contest, Girls Tennis (home and away were switched so as not to be the same as last year), Water Polo (start times moved to 4pm).
